Parking

Here are a few tips: Drive into Annapolis on Rowe Blvd. Bear right onto Calvert Street after you cross the bridge. Within one block there are two garages on the left - the first takes credit cards, the second takes cash. You can also park at the stadium and take a shuttle into town. If you don't mind a 10 minute walk and the two garages noted above are full, continue to West Street. Turn right, pass Lowe's Hotel on the right; keep going till you see a bright yellow painted building on the left. Turn left there and on the right is another parking garage - always has space! Most garages fill up early.
