It's time to begin planning for the 2022 legislative session.

Our priorities are informed by workgroups that address three major policy areas:



Front Door Workgroup

The Front Door Workgroup considers changes in how we strive to prevent crime and handle the pretrial process;

Behind the Walls Workgroup

The Behind the Walls Workgroup addresses issues related to people who are incarcerated, such as the effects of solitary confinement and the need for education;

Back Door Workgroup

The Back Door Workgroup recommends changes to help people returning from prison re-enter society, including measures to reduce recidivism (return to prison).
